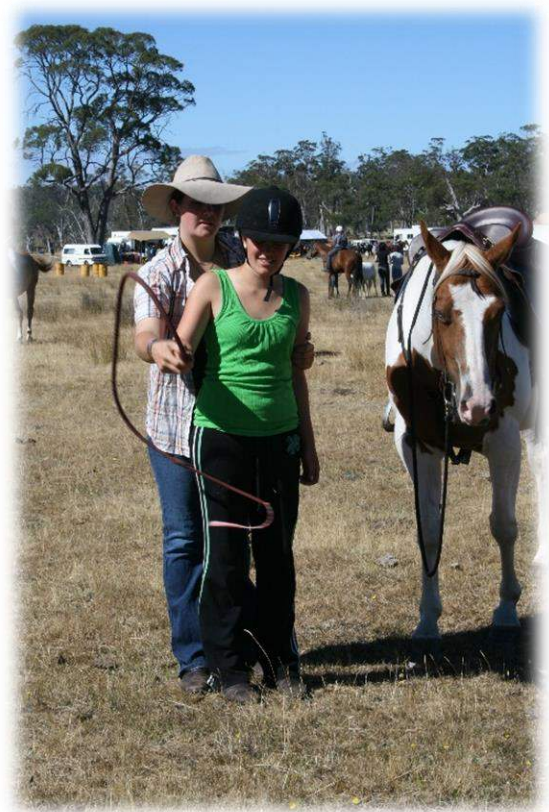

## NOVELTY EVENT SECTION

### HANDY STOCK HORSE EVENT DISCRPTION:

This event challenges riders of all ages to master horsemanship skills that are used daily in real life on the land. It is a great event to watch with obstacles to test the rider's and horse's knowledge and confidence.

Obstacles include a swinging bridge, gateway, sidestepping poles, hobbles and many more.

If you haven't been to a Mountain Cattlemen's Get Together before this is one event you will not want to miss.

### EVENT 17. WALKER DIGITAL SENIOR HANDY STOCK HORSE.

For riders 18 years and over on horses not competing in Championship event. Stock saddle compulsory. Format as for Championship Event.

### EVENT 18. BL\_NK DESIGNS HANDY STOCK HORSE 14-17 years

For riders 14-17 years of age and not competing in the Junior Championship. Stock saddle compulsory. Format as for Championship Event.

### EVENT 19. PROMED SENIOR BILLY CAN RACE.

Rules as per judge's instructions. First home with minimum of two thirds of a Billy-can be full of water is winner.

### EVENT 20. JANIE FINLAY JUNIOR BILLY CAN RACE.

For entrants 14 – 17 years. Rules as for event 19.

### EVENT 21. PAGE JUVENILE BILLY CAN RACE.

For entrants under 14 years. Rules as for event 19.

### EVENT 22. CAITLIN HOW PHOTOGRAPHY ADULT & CHILD BILLY CAN RELAY RACE

Children must be 14 years and under and not competing in event 19. Adults 18 yrs & over. Children mounted on their own horse on a lead rein. Adult is unmounted and assists the child.



## COOK THE STEW RULES:

Teams of 3

To be eligible for prizes teams must consist of:

- No more than one rider 18 or over
- Teams may have no riders 18 or over can all be juniors.
- Leading rein permitted.

Team members take in turns to collect an item for the stew from a drum.

It does not matter which order items are collected in.

Returning items must be dropped in the billycan before next rider can leave the start line.

Rider may dismount to put the item in the billycan.

First team home with all items in the billycan are the winners.

## EVENT 23. KAREN BIRD COOK THE STEW RACE

Teams of 3 riders consisting of at least one rider under 14 years and a maximum of one adult 18 years and over. Leading rein permitted. This event is a relay challenge incorporating a billy can, carrot, chop and potato! Great fun!

## EVENT 24. HORSELAND LAUNCESTON

### IAN ATKINS & GUNNY MEMORIAL SENIOR WALKING RACE.

For riders 18 years and over. To be held over a course of approximately 1.5 km of undulating terrain. Rules: If the horse breaks, a circle must be turned, and a walk re-established.

**EVENT 25. DAVIES CONTRUCTION  
REG DIXON MEMORIAL JUNIOR WALKING RACE.**

For riders under 14 - 17 years.

**EVENT 26. TABATHA BADGER JUVENILE WALKING RACE**

For riders under 14 years.

The time trial is a similar event to the handy stock, but speed is the objective. Great opportunity for non-Championship competitors to test their skill amongst the obstacle challenges.

**EVENT 27. MIKE BUSH OPEN TIME TRIAL**

For riders 18 years and over. A set course ridden at speed, any obstacles missed or not completed as per pattern will be a penalty plus 5 seconds.

**EVENT 28. SCOOT BOOT JUNIOR TIME TRIAL**

For riders under 14 - 17 years.

Mountain Muster Rules:

Person 1- (horse rider with saddle)

Start laying in swag- get out, roll up swag

Go to tied horse, saddle & mount

Jump two logs, pick up flag canter to unmounted rider pass the flag

Person 2 (no horse required)

Receives flag, eats breakfast (ingredients supplied)

Hobbles dummy horse

Puts up 4 post tape yard (must look like it would hold a horse overnight)

Picks up the calf runs to person 3

Person 3 (horse rider to be bareback)

Receives calf from person 2, walks over poles, place calf at the drum

Canter to tie up point, dismount & tie horse, unroll swag and gets in.

## Four phases included in the championship events.

### PHASE A. - Handy Stock Horse

A set course of obstacles including bridges, hobbles, carrying simulated calf and other obstacles you may encounter in a day's work for a stockman.

### PHASE B. – Cattle Handling Phase

Horse and rider to complete a prescribed course within a maximum time frame.

### PHASE C. – Whip Crack Phase - FRIDAY

10 whip crack targets on a set course. This will include natural bush logs. With points awarded for clean cuts! Will be a great challenge for any horse and rider combination.

### PHASE D. Mountain Horse

This section of the competition aims to demonstrate the horse's ability to work stock, accept a stock whip being cracked, allow the rider to open and close a gate, pick up a coat or similar items while under saddle without hesitation. The temperament of the horse should indicate a willingness to do the job at hand in a calm and relaxed manner with a good walk and paces on a light rein, as well as athleticism, and be responsive to the rider's commands to complete the pattern as requested. The pattern may include the already mentioned obstacles, or variances of these, and will include some faster work with a hand gallop, rollbacks or haunch turns, and natural (log) jumps.

None of the elements will be compulsory, however, failure to attempt an obstacle or movement will result in a zero score for that element only.

RULES- Each phase of the competition will be scored, and the top 5 senior, top juniors and top striplings will be run into the time trial phase which will be a final to determine the winner of each section and remain competitors to be ranked in order.

In the event of points being equal, there will be a count back to Cattle Handling, Handy Stock Horse, Whip Cracking and Mountain horse in that order.

1. Any competitor may be eliminated from any phase at any time by the presiding judge, which in turn eliminates the entrant from entire championship.
2. Entry restricted to financial members of the TMCA.
3. Membership form can be completed, and fee paid with entry.
4. Stock saddle compulsory.
5. Handy Stock Horse phase can be subject to a 'wild card' rule at the discretion of the judges.
6. Judge decision is final.
7. Any protest must be lodged within 1 hour of final presentations.
